
Re: *Non-Duty Disability/Spouse Class Members*

Dear Mr. Wilson:

This letter confirms that 230 non-duty disability retirees and spouses of non-duty disability retirees are Class Members who receive healthcare coverage under the terms of the parties' Settlement Agreement and Consent Judgment in *Weiler, et al v City of Detroit*, Wayne County Circuit Court, Case No. 06-619737.

The Plaintiff Class acknowledges, but does not agree with, the City's claim that non-duty disability retirees are ineligible for City-provided healthcare benefits, under any circumstances. Plaintiff Class also acknowledges, consistent with the terms of Section XIV (B)(4) of the Settlement Agreement, that the City has included these non-duty disability retirees and spouses of non-duty disability retirees as Class Members solely for the purpose of settling this Lawsuit.
